Campus Parking

<u>Undergraduate Move-in Days</u> are this weekend. Please expect more traffic on and around campus so and plan accordingly.

It is the Program's policy that students who wish to park on campus may do so by purchasing an annual student parking permit. However, for this academic year, the Program will also offer free parking for class days for your cohort only. Therefore, you have two parking options...

• Student purchased Parking Permit: good for the 2023-24 academic year (June 2023 through May 2024) and includes campus parking access every day and non-black-out parking dates. You may park in any student-designated lot on campus.

• Residency Weekend Free Parking Code. For this residency the code is **E2HAH28.** This code is valid for residency class days and non-black-out parking dates and is only for the pay-parking visitor lot next to the Walsh Architecture building. Morris Inn Update

Beginning August 7, the Morris Inn, Rohr's, and Cafe J implemented a cashless environment, joining the rest of the Notre Dame campus that has been cashless since the summer of 2022. For individuals who do not have a credit or debit card, kiosks have been installed in Duncan and LaFortune Student Centers where cash can be transferred to a Visa Gift card to complete transactions on campus. In addition, the ATM machine inside the Morris Inn will be converted to handle bills as small as \$5, should guests be looking for a way to obtain small amounts of cash. The website and hotel confirmations have been updated to reflect this change.
