Class Day/Game Day Protocol

Since you are required to be in class on a day when the campus is having a major event we have taken a few precautions on your behalf. Your cohort will have access to the Stayer building all weekend. We ask that you join us in being good stewards and not let anyone else in the building – even fellow ND students. We have granted swipe card access to all approved students, staff, and faculty. If you are staying for the Game you may choose to leave your bookbag or luggage in a designated Stayer breakout room. We will have a Room in Use sign on the door. This is not a locked room. It will have swipe card access but only for those approved to be in the building that day. Thus, this room while not completely secure has a low theft risk. Please use this option at your discretion.

Campus Parking

Thursday and Friday: The standard parking options are in place...

- Student-purchased Parking Permit: campus parking access in any student-designated lot on campus.
- Residency Weekend Free Parking Code. For this residency the code is WLVZU2K. This code is valid for the pay-parking visitor lot next to the Walsh Architecture building only. See [ND Campus Map](#) and search Walsh Architecture Visitors Lot

Saturday: The below Game Day Restriction apply...

- Parking will be available at the Innovation Center Lot with an approved parking pass. We will hand out the passes on Friday. Shuttle buses will be running their normal routes.
