### Details | Roundtrip Shuttle Transportation to SB for OSU vs. Notre Dame Game

Please take a moment to read the information regarding Saturday's shuttle. A grab-n-go lunch is set for Saturday, and you may either store your belongings in a breakout room and collect them when you return or take them with you on the bus. Other important details:

- Student Point of Contact: Michael Lindahl
- Bus Company: American Coach Limousine
- Pick-up Location: In front of the Dunkin' Donuts (62 E. Jackson Blvd)
- Board Time: 12:15 p.m.Departure Time: 12:30 p.m.
- Arrival into South Bend: The bus will park at the old St. Joe Highschool parking lot that is south of Holy Cross College (the parking lot address is 1441 N. Michigan Street, South Bend, IN 46617)
- Roundtrip Shuttle Service: Shuttles from the parking lot to campus will be available from 4:30 p.m. EST until one (1) hour after the game. If the bus arrives before 4:30 p.m. EST, the walk from this parking lot to the stadium is about 25 minutes down Angela Blvd.
- End of Game: Students must return to the bus at the same location/parking lot. Again, the shuttle from the parking lot to Holy Cross College is available for one (1) hour after the game. Michael Lindburg will inform the bus driver when all students are on board, and only then will you depart for Chicago.
- Drop-off Location: The bus will drop off at the exact location as departure on E. Jackson Blvd. If
  you decide to leave your belongings in a breakout room, you will need to enter the building on S.
  Michigan Ave., and you will need to have your proximity card.
