ParkMobile Access Code is: **DEC24**

Please access ParkMobile using this ([link](#)). Students must select "filters & access codes" and enter access code Dec24 to unlock the free parking in the Walsh Student Lot. This can be done before arriving on campus. Students do not need to display any pass to park in the Walsh Student Lot if they have redeemed the code through ParkMobile.

Additionally, parking is free in the Visitor Lots, Monday-Fridays, 4:00 PM - 8:00 AM, and there is no cost, nor permit required, to park on campus on the weekend.
