Class Day/Game Day Protocol

Your cohort will have access to the Stayer building all weekend. We have granted swipe card access to all approved students, staff, and faculty. If you are staying for the Game you may choose to leave your bookbag or luggage in designated Stayer breakout room 204. It will have swipe card access but only for those approved to be in the building that day. This room while not completely secure has a low theft risk. Please use this option at your discretion.

Campus Parking

Thursday and Friday: The standard parking options are in place...

- Student-purchased Parking Permit: campus parking access in any student-designated lot on campus.
- The Walsh Visitor Paid parking lot machines have been replaced. You may now reserve and pay for your parking space via the ParkMobile using this (link).
- Additionally, parking is free in the Visitor Lots, Monday-Fridays, 4:00 PM 8:00 AM, and there is no cost, nor permit required, to park on campus on a non-blackout weekend.
