Graduate Arrival

Graduates should enter the North Dome Joyce Center through [Gate 1](#). Check-in will open at 7:30 a.m. Please arrive in academic attire no later than 8:30 a.m. to ensure you can participate in the ceremony. Check-in will close at 8:30 a.m., and late arrivals may not be accommodated.

Academic Attire and Personal Belongings - Reminder

Please arrive at the ceremony dressed in your academic attire. Given space constraints, there is no dedicated area to store belongings, including large bags or purses. As you cross the stage, you will receive your diploma and have your picture taken with Dean Cremers. While you may leave personal belongings on your seat, we cannot guarantee graduates will return to their original seats.

Graduate Photos

The University is working with GradImages to capture official photographs of graduates at the various ceremonies. Photographs are available for pre-order through the GradImages [website](#) and will be available for purchase following the Commencement Weekend.

Guest Details

Guests can start arriving at 8:00 a.m. We will follow the same policies as the University Ceremony on permitted items in and around your diploma ceremony venue to ensure safety and security. You can read more about these policies [here](#). All guests should arrive through Gate 3.

If you have guests with special needs, they may be dropped off at [Gate 4](#). Please see an usher inside if further assistance with seating is needed. At the end of the ceremony, guests should meet graduates outside the venue.

Parking

Parking will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The lots closest to the diploma ceremony venue are the Joyce Lot and Stadium Lot. You can also review maps on the Mendoza Commencement [website](#). Remember that the university has many ceremonies throughout the weekend, and parking could be a challenge.
